- an area to improve for some students. Where staff feel it is appropriate, they will give one area for your child to focus on improving before the next report, set for February 2025. I have attached the same list used by staff when setting their improvement goals.
- an update on their attendance so far this year
- an update on the number of positives/negatives received since September. This number is not affected by their spending at the Positives Shop

This information will also be available to view on Go4Schools. You will be emailed when the report goes live, typically around 2pm on Thursday 24 October.
