## Simpler Recycling Legislation as of 31<sup>st</sup> March 2025

You may already be aware The UK government is implementing the Simpler Recycling Legislation, requiring businesses including Schools with 10 or more full-time employees to separate recyclables from general waste by 31st March 2025, with fines for non-compliance. This initiative aims to improve recycling rates, reduce contamination, and simplify waste management across the UK.
