Week 2 Friday - French in room 31

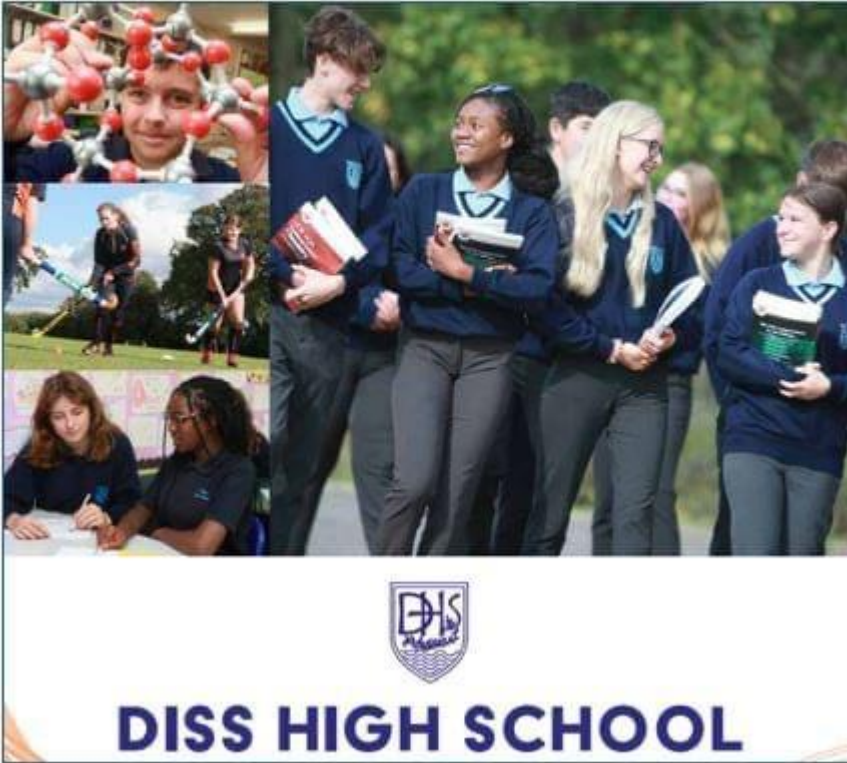
