## Pre - school challenge

- Pick up a challenge card at the library.
- Collect stickers as you look at books together.
- Visit the library 6 times and collect your certificate.



## Summer Reading Challenge

- Pick up a challenge poster at your library.
- Borrow and read 6 books or more visiting the library lots over the summer.
- Record the books you've read on your challenge poster, bring into the library each time you visit and show it to us.
- For each book you read you will get a sticker.
- Check for events and activities throughout the summer to help you finish the challenge.
- When you have read all 6 books let us know and you will get a medal and certificate - your library may have a special ceremony when these are presented, look out for posters.
